Bond University offers a range of full and part scholarships, bursaries and grants to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.

In 2018, 9 scholarships were awarded to Indigenous students due to the generous support of corporate partners, through funds raised at the Indigenous Gala and through a significant contribution by the University.

These scholarships, valued up to 50% of tuition fees for any single undergraduate degree (excluding the Medical Program) or 100% tuition for any diploma program, are awarded to Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander students who have demonstrated extracurricular involvement, leadership potential and academic achievements.

The Indigenous Scholarships are supported by generous alumni and community donations into the Ambition Fund.

#### **Eligibility**

- This scholarship is available to new commencing students at Bond University in the following year, January semester.
- Available to Australian citizens who are of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent (as defined by ABSTUDY).
- Applicants must have successfully completed, or be currently completing Year 12 at an Australian High School.
- Applicants must meet the prerequisites and the admissions entry standards for their chosen program.
