QUALIFICATION

MEM10119 Certificate I in Engineering qualification is based on units of competency selected from pathways described in the Metal and Engineering Package (MEM).

To achieve the qualification, students must achieve competence in one core unit of competency, and in 14 points from the specialisation units of competency.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The course consists of 1 core competencies and 7 Elective Competency Standard Unit points. A selection of the electives will be decided by the teacher delivering the course.

LEARNING EXPERIENCE

ASSESSMENT

Assessment for the modules of this subject is competency based. Students need to demonstrate that they complete all of the tasks required in the module to be considered competent. Assessment includes:

- practical projects;
- online safety tests;
- theory workbooks.

PATHWAYS

This subject could lead to careers in construction or engineering.

RESOURCES REQUIRED

Students are to provide safety wear: -

- cotton drill over shirt;
- ➤ safety glasses;
- leather topped shoes.

Access to internet at home is desirable.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

This is a two-year course. Students will be provided with every opportunity to complete the certificate as per the rights and obligations outlined in the VET Quality Framework. Students successfully achieving all qualification requirements will be provided with a Qualification and record of results. Students who achieve at least one unit (but not the full qualification) will receive a Statement of Attainment. This may provide RPL evidence for training providers such as TAFE Queensland.

Parents and students are also required to sign a Services Agreement prior to the students commencing a VET Qualification at Chanel College.
